SWIM COACHES

We are pleased to announce the return of Mark Faherty as head coach this season. Many old timers will recognize Mark as he led the Piranhas to successful seasons in 2006-2008. Mark grew up swimming in the Northern Virginia Swim League (NVSL) and has been coaching competitive swim teams since 1994. He was named "2008 Coach of the Year" by the Mount Vernon Region of the NVSL. Mark is currently the head coach of the Curl Burke Swim Club, Bethesda/DC Team.

Joining Mark as our Assistant Head Coach is Katie Brado. Katie swam in the NVSL and has coached summer league teams for many years. She is currently an instructional assistant working with learning and emotionally disabled middle school students at South County Secondary School. She is also an assistant coach with Curl-Burke Swim Club: J & M Swim, Alexandria, VA.

NVSL NEWS

There were three major NVSL rule changes this season that may affect your swimmer.

- The 8 and under age group will now have butterfly as a sanc tioned 25 meter/yard event during dual meets, a.k.a Sat Urday morning A meets.
- The 8 and under age group will now have a medley relay con sisting of backstroke, breast stroke, butterfly, and freestyle during Divisional Relay Carnival and All-Star Relay Carnival.

The eligibility of a swimmer to compete in a particular age group shall be determined by the swimmer's age on JUNE
 1st. Your child's age on June
 1st will now be their age for
 The entire season, regardless if they "age-up" during the swim season.

MEETS

The Piranhas kick off our 2012 season with Time Trials on Saturday, June 16th at 9am. This meet lasts about two hours and gives swimmers an opportunity to get times in each of the competitive strokes—freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, and butterfly.

MHC will compete in Division 5 of the NVSL this season. Our opponents for our five competitive Saturday meets are Langley, Sully Station, Cardinal Hill, Hunter Mill, and Waynewood. Sully Station will host Division Relays and

Cardinal Hill will host the Division Individual Championship. NVSL All-Star Relays will be at Lincolnia Park Pool and NVSL Individual All-Stars will be at Waynewood.

We have also scheduled 5 Monday night Developmental Meets, "B meets", against Fort Hunt area teams including Riverside Gardens, Hollin Meadows, Hayfield Farm, Mount Vernon Park, and Waynewood. Other local qualifying meets include the IM Invitational at Little Hunting Park and the Fort Hunt Sportsmen's Relays at Stratford Landing. MHC Financial Summary

In the special membership meeting in April 2012, club members approved a one-time \$50 special assessment fee for all applicable members.

The \$50 assessment fee notice will be sent around June 1 with a payment due date of July 31, 2012.

In the fall of 2011, a new sewer line was installed for the club which corrected a long standing issue we were experiencing with the drains at Mansion House Club.

Please send in your payment at anytime prior to the July 31st date. In thinking about the \$50, it is important to take into account the numerous recent improvements to the club.

Now, prior to the pool opening, the club will have a new main water line as well as a completely new parking lot. These projects were all large by themselves and total expenditure by Mansion House on these projects exceeded \$225,000.

However, through careful financial planning, the impact to membership has been kept to a minimum with the one-time \$50 charge. Keep this in mind on your first day at Mansion House for the 2012 season where you will see the results of these projects. Payments can be sent to MHC, PO BOX 30, Mount Vernon, VA 22121.
